## Top Tips for Helping Your Child in Spelling

#### Break the word into sounds

th-a-n-k d-i-a-r-y

#### Look for words within words

There's a 'hen' in 'when'.

You hear with your ear.

The word separate has 'a rat' in it

There are keys in donkeys

## Make up a silly sentence using the letters in a word (mnemonic)

big elephants can always understand small elephants - spells 'because' rhythm helps your two hips move - spells 'rhythm' necessary has one collar and 2 sleeves

### Say the word as it is written

Wednesday = Wed - nes - day Knight = K - night Gnome = G - nome

# Correct gently

A child can usually spell 80% of a word correctly. Use small ticks to show which letters are correct and talk about the part of the word which your child needs to remember.
